Adams Harrison Solicitors

Adams Harrison is a High Street legal practice. We recruit from apprenticeship level upwards, taking on legal administrators/accounts clerks as apprentices. We have trained school leavers to become legal secretaries. We train from within the firm and a number of our staff have become fully qualified legal executives, having started in junior roles. We also recruit graduates into positions as trainee solicitors.

AIM Apprenticeships

AutoRaise – apprenticeships in the automotive industry

AutoRaise is a charity that represents the vehicle repair industry. Its sole aim is to help address the acute skills crisis by attracting new people into the vehicle repair industry. A number of industry apprenticeships are available and are "craft based". Being able to repair, rebuild and repaint a vehicle after it has had an accident is a very skilled role and skilled technicians are needed.

Border Force

Border Force is a law enforcement command within the Home Office that secures the UK border by carrying out immigration and customs controls for people and goods entering the UK. Border Force employs staff through Apprenticeship programmes and colleagues based at Stansted Airport will be able to explain more about these and the career progression that is available through Border Force.

Edge Hotel School, University of Essex

The Edge Hotel School currently offer two-year degrees in Hotel Management and Events Management with Hospitality. Whilst tuition fees are still paid, by designing the courses to be completed over two years rather than three, the total amount for tuition fees is significantly reduced for these degree programmes.

Harlow College - Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are a great way to get into the world of work and launch your career. You'll usually spend 4 days per week in the workplace and one day per week at College. Apprenticeships are a job with training and can be a route to university level qualifications.
