



SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE AGREEMENT

Whilst there is no formal dress code agreement in the Sixth Form our students are invited to choose between smart, stylish dress or a more casual style.

With the right to self-expression comes the responsibility to adhere to the sixth form expectations of personal and social decency.

Appropriate footwear befitting of smart or casual styles should be worn at all times; particular care should be considered for students studying the natural sciences within a laboratory environment.

Unacceptable items of clothing:

- ❖ **Sports Wear** with the exception of **HRS** BTEC Sport kit and A Level Dancewear
- ❖ **MRFA** Football Academy training kit prior to leaving school for fixtures on a Wednesday afternoon
- ❖ **Jogging Bottoms**
- ❖ **Leggings unless** accompanied by a long length tunic/top/jumper
- ❖ **Hoodies of any description**
- ❖ **Flip Flops**

If we feel a student's clothing is in breach of our expectations they will be spoken to by their form tutor in the first instance and, in extreme circumstances, allocated an appropriate jumper, cardigan or trousers for the day. If students continue to wear unsuitable clothing they will be required to go home and change.
